Zion Lutheran School, 12075 Dorsett Rd., Maryland Heights vic., 1889



Maryland Heights is the location of the Zion Lutheran School. This Vermacular Victorian brick structure, the "Deutsch-Englisch Luth. Zions Schule," was constructed to house a parochial school founded in 1869. German was the only language spoken in the school until English was added as a "second language" in 1875. Instruction was done by church pastors and teachers from Lutheran colleges and seminaries. Classes continued until the latter part of World War I. The building was then used for various church functions. It was moved back from its original location by the Highway Department in 1981 to make room for road construction.
